

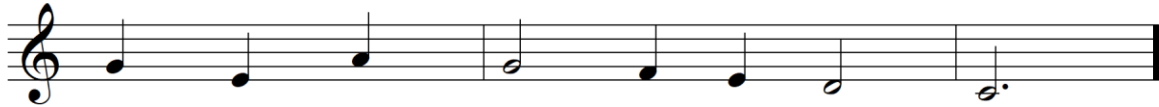
**HYMN OF THE DAY: O Sons and Daughters, Let Us Sing!**
