A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR PAT

Lent begins with Ash Wednesday on February 22.

We start our Lenten journey together at 11am and 7:00pm with our traditional services sharing the imposition of ashes and Holy Communion. Along with our Sunday morning worship time we will also gather on Wednesdays during Lent, on Maundy Thursday, and Good Friday.

I urge you all to make these services part of your preparation for the great Paschal Feast. As you reflect on the 40 days of Lenten discipline it would be well to remember the Ashes we share on that Holy Wednesday night made from branches of Palm. It was on our last Passion Sunday we together celebrated our Savior's triumphal entry into Jerusalem with such branches.

Ashes remind us of how seriously God takes sin. After our first parents' sin, they returned after death to the ground from which they were made.

Ashes have been used since the earliest times as a cleaning substance in the absence of soap, ashes point to cleansing and renewal.

Ashes remind us of our total dependence on God for life, for humans are created from only dust and God's breath. We are reminded of the fragility of our life. One day all of us will have these words spoken over us: "Earth to earth, ashes to ashes, dust to dust."

Ashes serve as a symbol of repentance according to ancient practice (Luke 10: 1-3).

This season of Lent let us renew our struggle with the sin which would cling so tightly, and the gift of life given to us in the precious sacrament Baptism.



Also, we ask you to make a commitment to God to open your Bible and use our Lenten devotional book "Amazing Grace" that will be coming in the mail from the church and pray each day.

We also are sending along with the Lenten Letter and Devotional Book a Worship Calendar for Lent, Holy Week, and Easter. Please join us this year for Wednesdays in Lent as we take **Journey of Stones**.

Drawing on the rich imagery of rocks and stones in scripture, we will be centered around the compelling metaphor of stones as representative of our sins. As we enter the Nave we will be invited to pick up stones as a concrete symbol of each sermon's theme; then as the service concludes the stones are placed back at the cross.
