A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR PAT

The festivals of Pentecost and the Holy Trinity always fall back-to-back in the church year. An old pastor friend of mine said these two festivals put a dual stamp on the close of the Easter season and the beginning of that of Pentecost.

Pentecost celebrates the coming of the promised Holy Spirit and marks the close of the Queen of Seasons, Easter. The Sunday following Pentecost is the festival of The Holy Trinity and the beginning of the Pentecost season.

Pastor Lynn Bailey wrote some years ago:

“This feast day celebrates one of the most dynamic truths of our faith: We worship one God who is three: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Unfortunately, this festival comes at a time of year when often our thoughts move toward beaches, mountains, and summer vacations upon the close of school.

Trinity Sunday has been observed since 1334 and is unique in that it is the climax to the first half of the Christian year. It is not as other festivals of the church here which oft times commemorate a specific event, or a particular person, rather it is a celebration of The God revealed in scripture as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

One great blessing this festival brings us is the opportunity to emphasize our participation in the life of the Trinity, a life into which we have been invited by Christ through our baptism.”

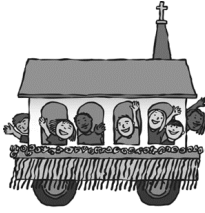

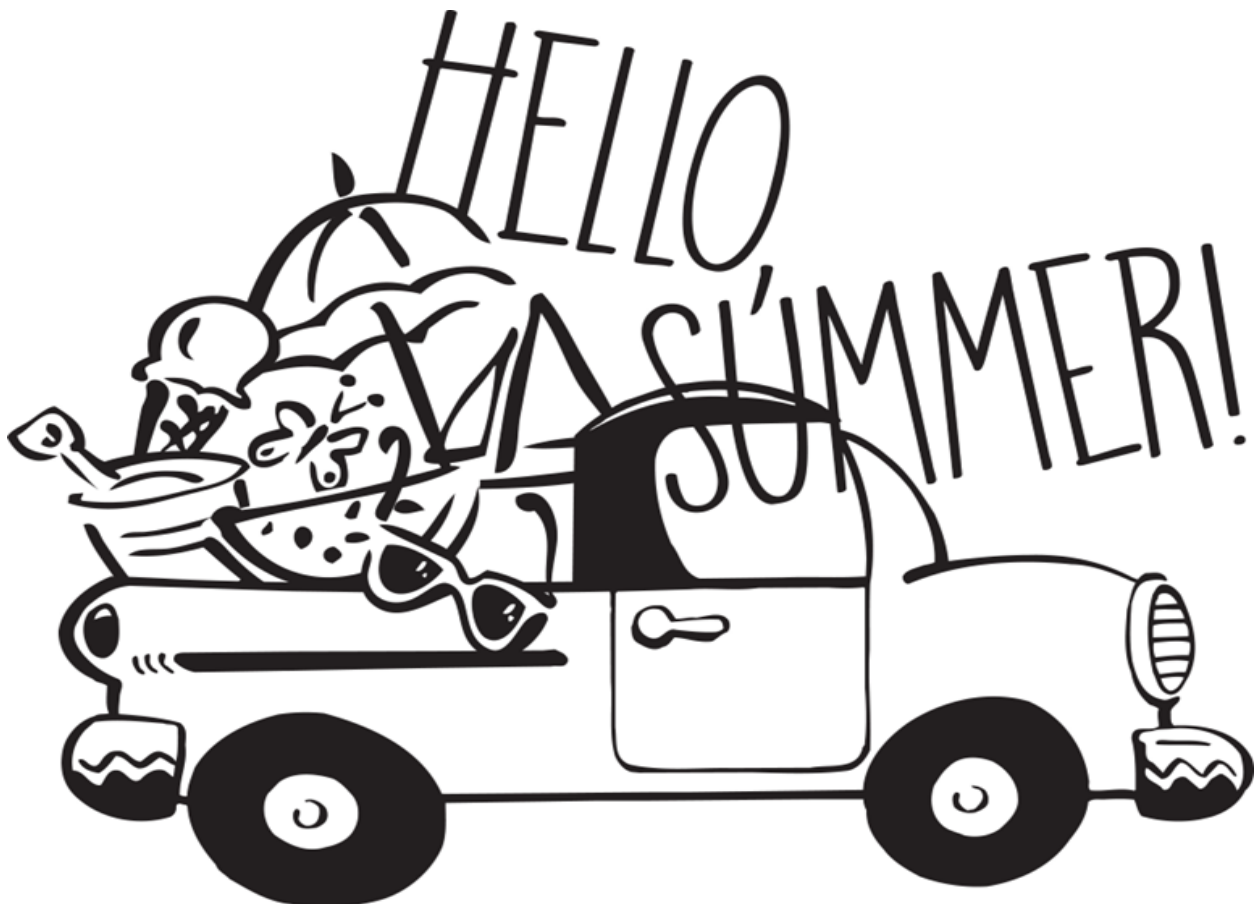
